PENALTY

Paragraph 33(a) of the Architects Act 1967 : “Any person, sole proprietorship, partnership or body corporate who procures or attempts to procure registration or a certificate of registration under this Act by knowingly making or producing or causing to be made or produced any false or fraudulent declaration, certificate, application or representation whether in writing or otherwise shall be guilty of an offence and shall, on conviction, be liable to a fine not exceeding fifty thousand ringgit or imprisonment for a term not exceeding two years or to both.”

Note :

- A sample of the proposed letterhead of the proposed architectural consultancy practice shall be enclosed. The letterhead shall show the name and qualifications of the *sole proprietor / partners.
- A copy of the letter from the last employer confirming the applicant’s resignation from the existing practice, where relevant, shall be enclosed.
- The application shall be accompanied with a processing fee for the amount of RM 50.00 and where the applicant is a sole proprietor or partner, a registration fee for the amount of RM 500.00 or RM 1,000.00, respectively in *money order / bank draft / cheque made payable to the Board of Architects Malaysia.
